

I am posting to request help on behalf of the Missionaries of Charity (MoC). The city of Minneapolis has permitted them to build a driveway onto their property at 1500 E. 24th St., Minneapolis. They have an architect doing the pro bono work to get the approval, but they need:

- a civil engineer willing to help do pro bono work
- a concrete company to do a driveway and step (required by the city) or an asphalt company to do the driveway plus a concrete company for the step

The sisters live completely on divine providence. They cannot do fundraisers as part of their order's rule. I cannot fundraise for them. However, I can tell you they would need to have all the work paid for because they do not have money. They currently park in the street. Last year, their van was vandalized. One sister suffered a stroke on All Saints' Day. It would be a blessing for them to park their van behind their convent to help the sister recover from a stroke and prevent future vandalism to their van.
