Position Overview:

We are looking for a dedicated **Foodscape Installation Leader** to join our team and oversee the construction of edible landscapes, foodscapes, and agroforestry projects. This key role will involve managing project execution, coordinating a crew of up to 6 workers, and ensuring that all work is completed to the highest standards of quality and craftsmanship.

The ideal candidate will have a background in horticulture and/or farming with a strong interest in learning about permaculture and edible landscaping. They should possess excellent spatial reasoning, math, and measurement skills. The role requires a natural leader who can manage a team of employees and contractors effectively, ensuring tasks are completed on time and within budget. The candidate should also be adaptable, solution-oriented, and capable of maintaining project schedules.

Preferred experience includes building small retaining walls. The candidate should have experience in managing projects, engaging with customers, working collaboratively, and staying flexible to meet project needs.

This is a seasonal position, starting in mid to late April and ending in mid-November (dependent on weather conditions). The role offers an estimated 35–45 hours per week, with potential overtime (over 40 hours per week) available for larger projects.

Responsibilities:

- Lead and supervise a small crew of landscapers, laborers, and subcontractors in the construction and maintenance of permaculture gardens
- Plan and coordinate daily work activities, including excavation of old landscaping, site preparation, measurements, digging swales to capture rainwater, sheet mulching, planting, soil preparation, mulching, seeding, installing trellises and drip irrigation, and hardscaping
- Interpret landscape design plans and ensure that projects are executed according to specifications and timelines
- Implement permaculture techniques and practices such as companion planting, water harvesting, soil conservation, and integrated pest management
- Manage project budgets, materials, and equipment and ensure efficient use of resources
- Monitor project progress, identify potential issues or challenges, and implement corrective actions as needed.
- Collaborate closely with clients, landscape designers, and project managers to ensure client satisfaction and project success
- Maintain a safe work environment and adhere to all safety regulations and company policies
